A rung spacing of 6 to 9 inches (150 to 230 mm) is preferable when. cable trays are equivalent. Is it possible to connect 2 cabletrays with a "branch piece (left picture)" instead of a "tee (right picture)". The tee has 3 connectors, the branch piece only has 1 connector. You can install cable in tray at 70% free-air current rating if covered more than 6' with "SOLID UNVENTILATED covers". It is very specific to unventilated covers.
