Underground cables are pulled in conduit that is buried underground, usually 1-1.2 meters (3-4 feet) deep to reduce the likelihood of accidentally being dug up. In extreme cold climates, cables may need to be buried at greater depths where there temperatures are colder and frost penetrates to. Fiber optic cable is sensitive to excessive pulling, bending, and crush forces. To ensure all specifications are met, consult the specific cable specification sheet for the cable you.
