

How to drill holes in the cover plate of a distribution box



Overview

Twist drills grab in thin material and drill three-lobed holes and can distort the material where you want it to be flat at the seal. 20mm is a bit small for a Greenlee style punch. Even a cheap one is better than nothing. What tools do I use to drill clean holes in both the plastic and aluminum enclosures so that the cable glands fit snugly without any gaps?

I tried searching for M20 drill bits and thread taping, but couldn't really find anything solid.
