

Is it permissible to wrap wires around the distribution box



Overview

While the tape is not mandated by every electrical code, it is a widely accepted best practice that adds a layer of protection against the movement and jostling that occurs when wires are folded back into a tight enclosure. The primary benefit is insulating the exposed side-terminals, or screw heads, on a receptacle or switch after the wires have been securely attached. Metal raceways, cable armor, and other metal enclosures for conductors shall be metallically joined together into a continuous electric conductor and shall be so connected to all boxes, fittings, and cabinets as to provide effective electrical continuity. No wiring systems of any. A distribution box is the heart of any electrical system. Is it safe to wrap hot and neutral wires individually with the black electrical tape?

I am. This is especially true during the rough-in phase of new construction: drilling holes, running wire, and nailing up boxes. Remodelers take on tasks as seemingly mundane installing a new light fixture. As an electrical contractor, I've hired many union and non-union electricians. The short answer is yes; it is generally safe to cover most wires with electrical tape.
