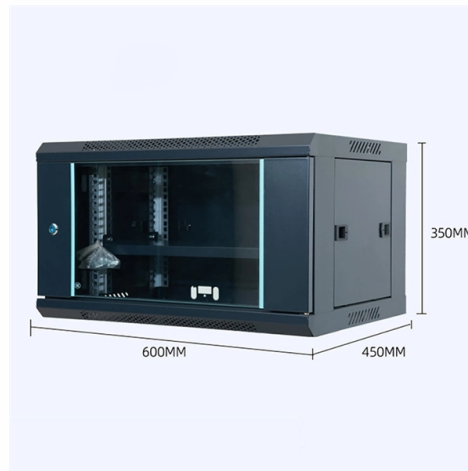


Marking of concealed electrical box



Overview

Each pull and junction box shall be neatly identified with permanent black marker or stick on labels on the outside of the box (where the box is concealed) and on the inside of the box (in exposed locations). Since these metal enclosures are rarely aesthetic, the desire to conceal them is understandable. Any modification, however, must prioritize safety and accessibility. The Electrical Safety Foundation International (ESFI) has reported over 2000 electrical workplace injuries and 126 fatalities due to electrical hazards in 2020.
