Arinaga, Canary Islands, Spain (Ports Europe) August 21, 2025 - The laying of a 49 million euro underwater fibre optic cable, linking Morocco and Spain's Canary Islands, will begin by the end of 2025. The cable is expected to become operational in 2028.
