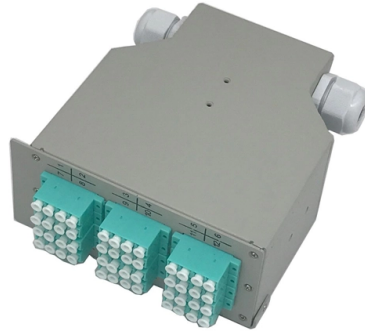


Newly Built Bridge in Ireland
