

Safe distance for installing electrical distribution box components



Overview

Approved Document M of the Building Regulations states that consumer units/fuseboxes should be mounted so that the switches are 1350-1450mm above floor level. Dedicated space: The space equal to the width and depth of electrical equipment in addition to the space extending from the floor to 6 feet above the equipment or structural ceiling. Ensure safe placement: install in dry, accessible areas with good ventilation and at appropriate height (typically ~1.
